CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by D. Scott, at 3:00 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: There were no public comments at the beginning of the meeting.

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – The minutes of the February 12, 2013 meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

B. OLD BUSINESS

1. Report from the March 2013 Board meeting: D. Scott reviewed the agenda from the last Board meeting and gave highlights of decisions made during the meeting. R. Colosimo reported on several policies that were revised and/or approved by the Board at the meeting.

C. NEW BUSINESS

1. Orientation of new committee members: There were no new committee members to orient.

2. Legislative update: F. Olmstead, D. Scott, and S. VanBeuge gave updates of pending legislation being considered by the Legislature. Issues that were discussed included numeric staffing ratios, full practice authority for APNs, truth in advertising, and the process of promulgation of regulations. F. Olmstead described the process by which legislation is considered, passed, or fails.
3. Review, discussion and action regarding the regulation of post-licensure nursing education programs: R. Colosimo discussed the findings of research that has been done, including which states regulate advanced practice nursing education and issues involved in regulating post licensure programs. Since it would require legislation to allow the NSBN to regulate these programs, the committee decided to postpone further discussion until a later date.

D. RECOMMENDATIONS FOR AGENDA ITEMS FOR NEXT MEETING: There were no recommendations for agenda items for the next meeting.
