### **Regulations Approved**

Reno, NV, May 5, 2016 – The Nevada Legislative Counsel Bureau votes to adopt regulations proposed by the Nevada State Board of Nursing.

On April 4, 2016, the Nevada Secretary of State filed three regulations proposed by the Nevada State Board of Nursing, thereby making those regulations effective. One of the regulations concerned the clarification of the scope of practice of Licensed Practical Nurses in Nevada. Another regulation concerned the education and experience necessary for an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse to make determinations about the custody of certain persons. Finally, a regulation was passed that detailed the requirements for a program for the education of nurses.
