

Advanced Practice Registered Nurse Continuing Education Requirement

Legislature mandated APRN CEs

Pursuant to NAC 632.291 (1.) It is required an APRN has completed satisfactorily 45 hours of continuing education directly related to his or her role or population of focus, which may include the required 30 hours of continuing education for renewal of a license for a registered nurse.

The 2017 Nevada legislature passed Assembly Bill 105. Beginning July 1, 2017 an advanced practice registered nurse is required to complete within 2 years after initial licensure and every 4 years thereafter, at least 2 hours of training relating to evidence-based suicide prevention and awareness. The bill's requirements are incorporated into the Nevada Nurse Practice Act NRS 632.343.

The 2017 Nevada legislature also passed Assembly Bill 474. Beginning January 1, 2018 an advanced practice registered nurse (APRN) who is registered to dispense controlled substances pursuant to NRS 453.231 is required to complete at least 2 hours of training relating specifically to the misuse and abuse of controlled substances, the prescribing of opioids or addiction during each period of licensure. The bill's requirements are incorporated into the Nevada Nurse Practice Act NRS 632.2375.

The Board conducts random audits to ensure compliance. Failure to complete the required continuing education, or failure to produce evidence of CE/training completion when audited, may result in disciplinary action. Retain copies of continuing education/training for four years in case of an audit.

The Board does not approve individual continuing education courses. However, for your reference, we've included below a brief listing of approved continuing education providers whose courses appear to meet the legislative intent for the course.
