8. Notice of Proposed Regulation Public Adoption Hearing Pursuant to NRS 233B.061(2): (For Possible Action)

Amendment of Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 632.210; 632.211: The proposed amendment to NAC 632.210 would establish an advisory committee concerning the practice of licensed practical nurses, and would revise the duties of an advisory committee concerning certain issues relating to impairment and substance abuse. The proposed amendment to NAC 632.211 would be to repeal that regulation because the duties and responsibilities of the advisory committee concerning certain issues relating to impairment and substance abuse would be moved to NAC 632.210. 9. Notice of Proposed Regulation Public Adoption Hearing Pursuant to NRS 233B.061(2): (For Possible Action)

Amendment of Section 1 of LCB File No. R105-15: The proposed amendment to Section 1 of LCB File No. R105-15 is based upon Senate Bill No. 227 of the 79th Session of the Nevada Legislature which expanded the list of persons who are authorized to evaluate a person upon the emergency admission of the person to a mental health facility or hospital to include an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) who has obtained certain psychiatric training and experience. Senate Bill No. 227 requires the Nevada State Board of Nursing to adopt regulations prescribing the psychiatric training and experience necessary before an APRN may complete the evaluations. (LCB File No. R126-17).
