Notice of Proposed Regulation Public Adoption Hearing  
Pursuant to NRS 233B.061(2):

Amendment of Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 632.237: The proposed amendment to NAC 632.237 is in response to Assembly Bill No. 474 of the 79<sup>th</sup> Session of the Nevada Legislature which required the Nevada State Board of Nursing to adopt a regulation to require Advanced Practice Registered Nurses, who have the authority to prescribe controlled

substances, poisons, dangerous drugs, or devices pursuant to NRS 632.237, to complete at least two hours of continuing education that relate to the misuse and abuse of controlled substances, the prescribing of opioids, or addiction. (LCB File No. R062-18).
