When the registered nurse has had theory and supervised clinical practices in a BoN approved course, and policies/proced-ures of the employing agency are clearly stated: the RN may do amniotomy, the RN may place spiral (fetal scalp) electrodes, the RN may insert prostagle did suppositories or gel for the induction of labor when fetal demise has occurred. 2. The insertion of an intrauterine pressure catheter (IUPC) is outside the legal scope of practice for the registered harse. Placement of IUPC is not an emergency; the procedure is a medical function and potential sequelae demand immediate redical intervention. Unlicensed partons may not perform acts that constitute the practice of nursing as defined in NRS 632.
