## NEVADA STATE BOARD OF NURSING

## Practice Decision LPN Scope of Practice Regarding Suprapubic Catheter Replacement

The Nevada State Board of Nursing finds that it is within the scope of practice of a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) who is educationally prepared and properly trained per <u>NAC 632.232</u> and <u>NAC 632.242</u> to replace a suprapubic catheter.

The suprapubic catheter replacement is via a well healed established pathway and limited to being replaced in no less than four weeks after initial placement.

The educationally prepared and properly trained LPN must:

- Follow clinical practice guidelines from Society of Urologic Nurses and Associates for Suprapubic Catheter Replacement addressing the knowledge and skills for completing proper assessment, procedure and documentation.
- Follow applicable written procedures and policies approved by medical staff and the nursing administration of the employing agency.
