On March 22, 2020, Nevada Governor Steve Sisolak signed Declaration of Emergency Directive 006. Section 1 of that Emergency Directive suspended the requirement contained in NRS 241.023(1)(b) that there be a physical location designated for meetings of public bodies. Section 3 of that Emergency Directive suspended the requirements contained in NRS 241.020(4)(a) that public notice agendas be posted at physical locations within the State of Nevada.

This meeting of the Disability Advisory Committee will take place exclusively through telephonic means based upon Nevada Governor Steve Sisolak's Declaration of Emergency in the State of Nevada in response to COVID-19, and upon the Nevada State Board of Nursing's obligation to timely conduct Board business.

The Disability Advisory Committee meeting will commence at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 14, 2021. Persons who have business before the committee are responsible to see they are in attendance at the time such business transpires.

The Disability Advisory Committee advises the reports to the Board regarding Nurses and CNAs with disabilities or practice issues which impact the delivery of safe and effective nursing.

2. Public Comment will be taken at the beginning and at the end of the Committee meeting;
3. Those individuals wishing to present concerns to the Committee are to sign in prior to speaking;
4. Depending on the number of individuals wishing to address the Committee, a time limit for each may be set. The committee will not restrict comments based upon viewpoint;
5. If no one appears to speak, the Committee will proceed with its regular business meeting;

6. Action will not be taken on any issues presented during the Public Comment period. In accordance with Nevada Open Meeting Law, any issue requiring action will be placed on the agenda for a future Committee meeting.
