CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by S. Miller at 3:01 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: D. Etli motioned to approve the November 9, 2021 minutes as written. P. Burgio Seconded. Motion Carried

B. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Review, discussion of need for edits or updates to NAC 632.890 as they pertain to advanced practice nursing. The committee discussed and decided a subcommittee is necessary to further address revisions to NAC 632.890. P. Burgio, D. Etli, J. Packham,

and A. Bellow will work together on the subcommittee, S. McCord will work with the committee. Board staff will coordinate a date for the subcommittee to meet.

C. NEW BUSINESS

1. C. Dinauer gave an update from the November 2021, January 2022 and the emergency February Board meeting. The emergency Board meeting that took place in February was related to having an emergency regulation change to the nursing apprentice program. The change would expand where a nurse apprentice can practice, the change would help with the Nevada nurse shortage. The Board approved the emergency regulation change and has since gone before the Governor's office, the Secretary of the State's Office and through the Legislative Counsel Bureau. C. Dinauer gave a brief update regarding the November and January Board meetings, the Board conducted its regular business such as looking and reviewing nursing programs, CNA programs, NCLEX and CNA pass rates. Scope of practice questions were presented to the Board.
2. F. Olmstead gave the legislative update regarding the second regulation change that was approved at the emergency Board meeting related to nursing delegation. The regulation will have definitions added about assignment and delegation. There will be a workshop held and all the information gathered from the workshop will be reported to a Board Hearing and then off to the legislative Counsel. The total process can take four months provided there are no issues with the proposed changes.
3. S. Miller presented an update regarding quarterly Scope of Practice Questions, the committee did not have any questions regarding the presented data.
4. Barbara Day the new APRN consultant introduced herself to the committee, the committee welcomed her.
