session, and the Interim Committee on Commerce and Labor has filed a bill draft request in support of the Nurse Compact. The Board will be celebrating its 100th anniversary, updates for the celebration will be posted on the website. The Board has changed the format of the New Magazine to a Newsletter format that will be specific to nursing practice, law, and news that would impact licensees. The Board approved Ms. Coss's reappointment application to the LPN committee for another three-year term. The Board had revisions related to the Jackson Pratt Practice Decision and returned the decision to the Nursing Practice Advisory Committee to review.
