2. What policies do I need for a Nursing Assistant Training Program?	Policies include, but not limited to: Admission, continuance, dismissal, absence, reimbursement/refund, grading, retakes, and additional policies specific to the program.
3. What does the syllabus need to include?	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A breakdown of the hours for lecture, lab and clinical. 2. Behavioral objectives for each unit of instruction. 3. Methods used to teach each unit of instruction. 4. Methods used to evaluate the achievement of behavioral objectives. <p>*Most textbooks have crosswalks that have behavioral objectives for each unit.</p>
4. Where can I find the scope of practice for a CNA to create a skills checklist?	The Nevada State Board of Nursing CNA Skills Guidelines can be used as a guideline for CNA scope of practice. Nevada State Board of Nursing CNA Skills Guidelines
5. Do students need to be BLS CPR certified prior to clinical?	Yes. Students must have their AHA BLS for Healthcare Providers prior to any physical contact with residents and/or patients.
